If you are new to the neighborhood, this sale and the spring plant sale is the Association's means of funding neighborhood projects: Beautification projects such as the monument, median landscaping and sprinkling system, the annual Ice Cream Social, the Welcoming Committee, the Neighborhood Crime Watch Committee, the Civic Affairs Committee with many of the fliers delivered to neighbors regarding the development at the corner of Central and Walnut Hill, etc. We also plan to have sign toppers made to identify the neighborhood.

If you plan to be out of town next Saturday and would like your order to be delivered when you return, just make a note on the order form when you want them delivered and I will keep them watered until then.
